Change:

God, open my eyes that I might see Belmont as You see it. Let me
sow change that needs to take place, even if it is painful to me.
Use me to be an instrument of that change whatever the cost.

Perspective:

Lord, let me see Belmont Church with freshness, honesty, and open
eyes. Help me to grasp where we have gotten out of balance in any
of our ministries. Give our church vision to make a difference in our
community. Even more, God, use me to be a catalyst and
instrument for the change that must take place in Belmont Church.

Words of Life:

Holy Spirit, help us to choose words of life, to speak and pray those
words – words of life for me, my family, my church and my sphere
of influence. Reveal to me words of life to speak to those around
me – those who are hurting, lost or discouraged. Reveal me words
of life to speak to leaders, staff, family and guests
at Belmont Church.

Facilities/Material Items:

Lord, teach me to properly steward the material items You give me
personally and in my church. Help me keep perspective on what
really matters and avoid obsession or idolatry in my stewardship.

Purpose:

God, reignite passion for the Gospel in the hearts of Belmont
members. Teach us to share the gospel with others. Teach us to live
as men and women who are true bearers of the good news of Jesus
Christ. Remind us of our purpose. Convict us of our purpose.
Empower us to live our purpose.

The Great Commission:

Lord, remind me that I am a Great Commission Christian in a Great
Commission church. Remind me that, in Your strength, I am to do
whatever it takes to reach out into my community with the
transforming power of the gospel.

Heroes:

God, give me the conviction and the courage to be like the heroes
of Hebrews 11. Teach me not to hold on to those things at Belmont
Church that are my personal preferences and styles. Show me not
only how to let go, but where to let go, so that I may heed Your
commands more closely.

PRAYING THE SCRIPTURE

Humility and Repentance:

*2 Chronicles 7:14 – If my people, who are called by my name, will
humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their
wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin
and will heal their land.*

Please go before Jesus to ask His help for us to humble ourselves,
see our need of Him, return to Him in any places where we have
drifted from devotion to Him – individually and corporately – and
to stir in us a passion to prayer so that our joy in Him may be full.

Excel in Love:

*Mark 12:29-31 – Jesus answered, “The foremost [commandment] is,
‘Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is one Lord;’³⁰ and you shall love the
Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all
your mind, and with all your strength.’³¹ The second is this, ‘You shall
love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater
than these.”*

Pray fervently that the Father will strengthen us in our spirits so
Jesus can find His home in our hearts, and we can be rooted and
founded in His love and know it experientially. May the overflow of
this love of the Father personally flow out of us so we have Jesus’
love for one another.

Awake My Soul:

*Ephesians 5:14-17 – For this reason it says, “Awake, sleeper, And arise
from the dead, And Christ will shine on you.”¹⁵ Therefore be
careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise,¹⁶ making the
most of your time, because the days are evil.¹⁷ So then do not be
foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.*

Pray for personal and corporate awakening to be passionate in love
for Jesus and what He is doing in our day. Pray that we are alert and
have ears to hear what the Spirit is saying to us individually and to
Belmont Church and that we will exert ourselves to obey. Pray for
wisdom, both individually and corporately.

Oneness:

*John 17:20-23 – I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those
also who believe in Me through their word;²¹ that they may all be one;
even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us,
so that the world may believe that You sent Me.²² The glory which You
have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We
are one;²³ I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity,
so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as
You have loved Me.*

Pray that we receive Jesus’ power to be united in heart and purpose
with the Holy Spirit and with each other, doing the works Jesus did
and greater, that we may do only what we see the Father doing
and hear Him saying. Pray for the Father to bring His order to
Belmont Church in every way so that we fulfill His purposes
for us in our day.
